EHF FINAL4 DRAW

I DRAW PREVIEW

Since the completion of the EHF Champions League Men 2021/22 quarter-finals last week, the line-up for the EHF FINAL4 in Cologne on 18/19 June has been confirmed: THW Kiel, Telekom Veszprém HC, Lomza Vive Kielce and Barça. The question who is going to play who in the semi-finals will be answered during a draw at the EHF office in Vienna on Tuesday (24 May).

The draw ceremony starts Tuesday at 11:00 CEST and will be streamed live on EHFTV and covered on the official EHF Champions League social media channels.

The four teams will be drawn from the same pot, following these steps:

- step 1: first team drawn for semi-final 1;
- step 2: first team drawn for semi-final 2;
- step 3: second team drawn for semi-final 1;
- step 4: second team drawn for semi-final 2.

The semi-finals 1 and 2 will not necessarily be played in that order at the EHF FINAL4; the exact playing schedule for Saturday 18 June will be announced in due time. The two losing semi-finalists will contest the third-place match on Sunday 19 June, followed by the two winners playing the big final.

Four players - one for each participating teams - will join the event virtually and will comment on the draw result. Gonzalo Pérez de Vargas for Barça, Alex Dujshebaev for Lomza Vive Kielce, Sander Sagosen for THW Kiel and Rasmus Lauge for Telekom Veszprém HC.

The EHF FINAL4 2022 brings together four teams that have already left their mark on the EHF Champions League season with their strong performances that earned them the ticket to Cologne.

Titleholders Barça return to LANXESS arena to defend their title after two commanding wins over SG Flensburg-Handewitt in the quarter-finals.

Kielce had a similar run over the last two weeks with two convincing wins over another former champion, Montpellier HB.

Seeking their first title, Veszprém booked their spot at the EHF FINAL4 despite a second-leg defeat at Aalborg Håndbold, having clearly won the home leg last week.

And in the closest quarter-final tie, Kiel came from behind on home court to edge Paris Saint-Germain Handball by a single goal in the Match of the Week Thursday, eight days after the teams had settled for a draw in Paris.

The four teams will use the remaining time until the 18/19 June weekend to get the best possible preparation for the EHF FINAL4 2022, as the EHF Champions League awaits yet another spectacular end to its season.

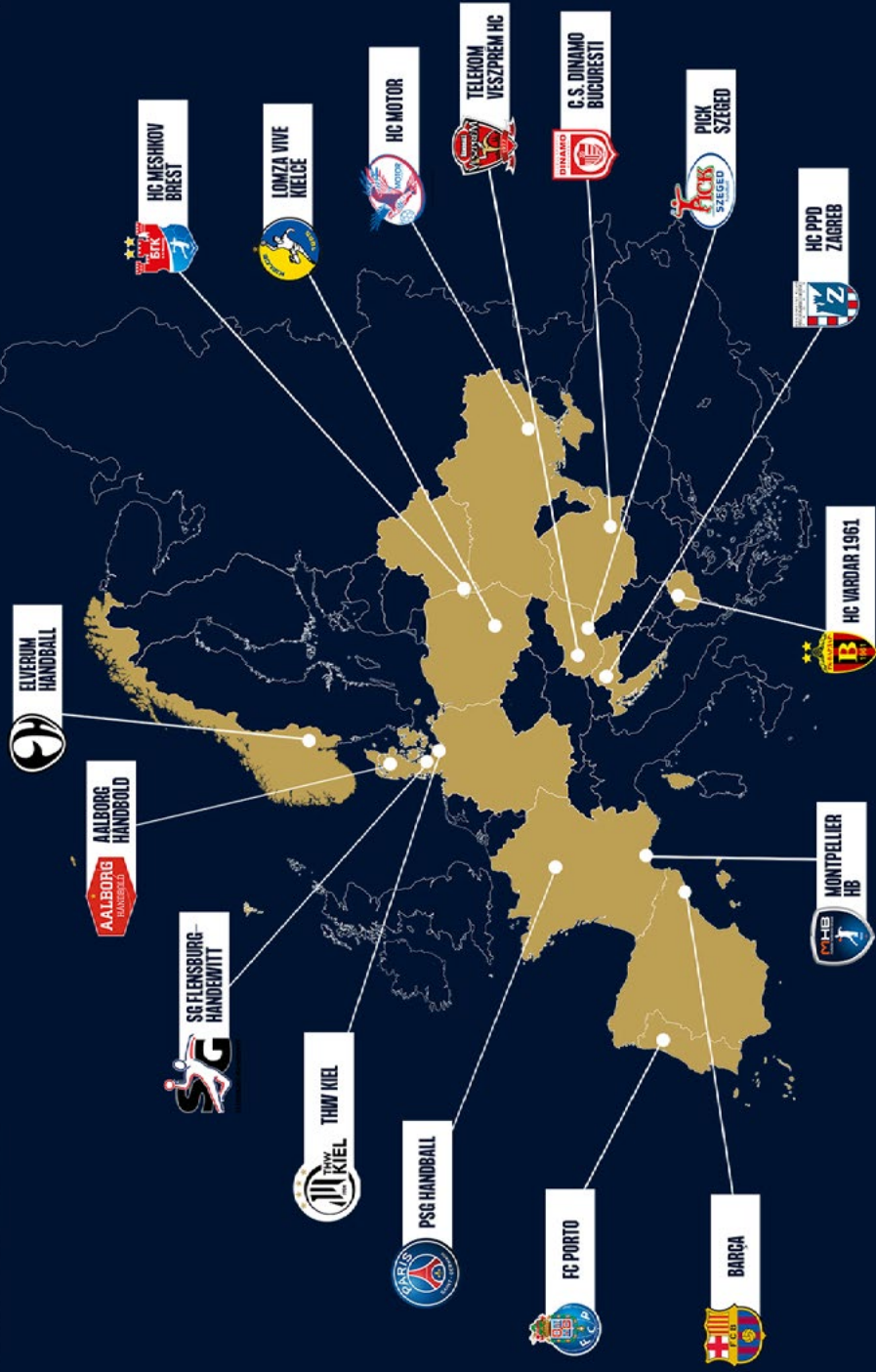

I ALL FOUR COACHES HAVE WON THE TROPHY AS PLAYERS

FACTS AND FIGURES: THE MOST IMPORTANT NUMBERS PRIOR TO THE START OF THE QUARTER-FINALS

Since last week, the four participants of the EHF FINAL2 MEN 2022 are confirmed: Kiel, Veszprém, Kielce and Barça, exactly the same line-up as in 2015. But did you know that all four head coaches had been EHF Champions League winners as player? Or that six multiple EHF Champions League winners are part of the squads? Here are many more Facts and Figures about the four teams

0 not a single team defended the trophy at Cologne since the implementation of the EHF FINAL4 in 2010 – in twelve editions, now Barça have the chance to do so

time only - in 2018 - neither a German nor a Spanish team was part of the EHF FINAL4 - this season, now it is two: Barça and Kiel 1 former EHF Champions League top scorer is still part of the competition: Alex Dujšebaev (Kielce/2018/19), Filip Jicha (2008/09 and 2009/10) is Kiel's coach, Momir Ilic (2013/14, 2014/15) is Veszprém's coach.

1 goal in aggregate was the smallest margin in the quarter-finals, when Kiel beat PSG 63:62

1 team only from the EHF FINAL4 2021 is still in competition: the winners and defending champions Barça - Nantes played in the European League, Aalborg and PSG failed in the quarter-finals

2 teams won both quarter-final matches: Barça (against Flensburg) and Kielce (against Montpellier)

2 former EHF Champions League winners failed in the quarter-finals: Montpellier (2003, 2018) and Flensburg (2014)

2 former or current IHF World Handball Players of the Year are part of the 4 squads in Cologne, both from THW Kiel: Domagoj Duvnjak (Kiel/2013) and

Niklas Landin (Kiel/2019 and 2021). Besides, two coaches had previously been IHF Players of the Year: Talant Dujšebaev (Kielce) and Filip Jicha (Kiel)

2 Spanish coaches are part of the EHF FINAL4: Talant Dujšebaev (Kielce) and Carlos Ortega (Barça)

2 Barça players are still in the race for their individual fourth EHF Champions League title: Aitor Arino, and Gonzalo Perez de Vargas

2 sons of Champions League winning fathers rose the trophy in Cologne: Alex Dujšebaev with Vardar in 2017 and Melvyn Richardson with Montpellier in 2018 - and both are back at Cologne again with Kielce (Dujšebaev) and Barça (Richardson)

3 former or current EHF Champions League champions representing 13 trophies have made it to Cologne: Barça (9), Kiel (3) and Kielce (1)

3 times, Kiel (2010, 2012, 2020) and Barça (2011, 2015, 2021) have won the trophy at Cologne to be record winners

3 clubs took their titles at the EHF FINAL4 at Cologne, which already were victorious in the old playing system: Barça (1996-2000, 2005), Kiel (2007) and Montpellier (2003).

times at Cologne (2015, 2016, 2019) and four times in total, Veszprém have been EHF Champions League finalist - and never won the trophy

3 of the four EHF FINAL4 participants had skipped the play-offs as group winners or runners-up: Kielce, Barça and Kiel - Aalborg were eliminated by Veszprém

3 persons won the EHF Champions League as a player and a coach - Talant Dujšebaev, Roberto Parrondo and Filip Jicha - and two of them (Dujšebaev and Jicha) are still in the race for another trophy. Jicha is the only one, who won all trophies in Cologne. Barça coach Carlos Ortega can follow in this line now.

4 - which means all - teams still in competition have already been part of the EHF FINAL4 in Cologne - and four the first time, a line-up is the same with a previous edition: in 2015, Veszprém, Barça, Kiel and Kielce had also qualified, and Barça took the trophy

4 times only in now 13 years, the defending champions made it to Cologne: Barcelona in 2012 and 2022, Kiel in 2013 and Vardar in 2018

4 - which means all head coaches of the 4 EHF FINAL4 participants have won the Champions League as players: Carlos Ortega (Barça/six times with Barça), Talant Dujšebaev (Kielce/Santander), Momir Ilic (Veszprém) and Filip Jicha (Kiel) together with Kiel in 2010 and 2012

4

of 107 group matches decided on court ended with a gap of ten and more goals - and none of the 8 play-off matches and 8 quarter-final matches

6 multiple EHF Champions League winners are part of the four squads at Cologne: Gonzalo Perez de Vargas, Aitor Arino, Ludovic Fabregas, Luka Cindric, (both Barça), Domagoj Duvnjak and Steffen Weinhold (both Kiel), besides the three coaches Carlos Ortega (Barça), Momir Ilic (Veszprém) and Filip Jicha (Kiel) are multiple winners as players

6 countries are represented by the previous 26 EHF Champions League champions: Spain (15 titles), Germany (7), France (2), North Macedonia (2), Poland and Slovenia (each 1)

7 different clubs won the trophy at Cologne: Kiel and Barça each three times, Vardar twice, Hamburg, Flensburg, Kielce and Montpellier each once

8 goals was the biggest gap in a single quarter-final match, when Kielce beat Montpellier 30:22

9 times (1995-2000, 2011, 2015, 2021) FC Barcelona have won the EHF Champions League to be the record winner. In addition, they won the Champions Cup (forerunner competition of the Champions League) once. Kiel (2007, 2010, 2012, 2020) have won four trophies, Kielce one

9 different Spanish coaches steered their teams to an overall of 18 EHF Champions League trophies so far: Valero Rivera (5), Dujšebaev (4), Xavi Pascual (3), Javier Cuesta, Julian Ruiz, Francisco Equisoain, Francesc Espar, Raul Gonzalez and Roberto Parrondo (each 1). Dujšebaev, Parrondo and Gonzalez were the only ones to win the trophy with Non-Spanish teams - now Ortega can extend this series

10 times in 13 edition (including 2022) Barça have qualified for the EHF FINAL 4, for Kiel is the eighth appearance, for Veszprém the sixth and for Kielce the fourth

13 goals in the 2021 final Barcelona vs Aalborg (36:23) were the biggest margin in all 24 matches at the EHF FINAL4 at Cologne so far

15 times Spanish teams have won the EHF Champions League - Barcelona (9), Ciudad Real (3), Santander, Irun and Portland (each 1)

15 goals were the biggest in the group phase, when Veszprém beat Bucharest 47:32, the biggest gaps in the quarter-finals were eight goals

16 of the 123 matches since the start of the group phase and decided on court, ended by a draw, 12 in the group phase, 3 in the play-offs and 1 in the quarter-finals (PSG vs Kiel 30:30)

matches, Veszprém had to play until they arrived at their final destination, as they were the only team, which did not skip the play-offs, Kiel, Kielce and Barça only played 16 matches

19 goals, scored by Zagreb in the 19:20 defeat against Vardar, were the low-score of a single team since the start of the group phase, in the play-offs it were Montpellier's 22 goals at Kielce (22:30)

20 victories in 20 matches were taken by Barça in their perfect season 2020/21 - this season, they

have already lost three times and tied twice in the group stage - but won both quarter-finals

20 times, Aron Palmarrsson was on court at the EHF FINAL4 in Cologne for Kiel, Veszprém and Barcelona to be record holder in terms of matches - as he failed with Aalborg against Veszprém, he cannot add more matches this year

22 times including the 2021/22 season, Kiel and Barcelona had each made it at least to the quarter-finals of the EHF Champions League, Veszprem played their 20th quarter-final, Kielce their fifth

33 away victories were among the 123 matches decided on court, since the start of the group phase, including two in the quarter-finals: Barça's 33:29 at Flensburg and Kielce's 31:28 at Montpellier

39 goals were the low-score since the start of the group phase, when Vardar beat Zagreb 20:19, the second lowest number (45) funny enough was in the reverse fixture, when Zagreb beat Vardar 23:22. The lowest score in the play-offs were the 51 goals at Barça vs Flensburg (27:24)

is Barça's goal difference after 16 matches - they are ahead of Kielce (+45), Veszprém (+39) and Kiel (+33) before the EHF FINAL4

63 times in 123 matches decided on court since the start of the group phase - including five of eight play-off matches and quarter-finals each, 60 or more goals were scored

74 times in 123 matches decided on court since the start of the group phase, the home teams were victorious, including four play-off matches and five quarter-finals

79 goals were twice the high-score since the start of the group phase, in both cases Veszprém were involved and victorious: in the 47:32 against Bucharest and in the 40:39 at Paris. And Veszprém were even part of the high-score in the quarter-finals with 72 goals: the 35:37 defeat at Aalborg

90 goals were scored by Barça's right back Dika Mem to top the list prior to the EHF FINAL 4,

second rank Felix Claar (Aalborg/88 goals) and third ranked Kamil Syprzak (PSG/86 goals) are already out of the competition.

265 victories in 348 EHF Champions League matches (besides 22 draws and 61 defeats) were taken by Barça so far to top the All-Time Champions League table

486 goals were scored in the eight quarter-final matches (eight more than in the eight play-offs), which means an average of 60.75 goals.

2,814 goals were scored in total in the previous 12 editions of the EHF FINAL4 in Cologne

7,372 goals were scored in those 123 matches since the start of the group phase and decided on court, including 6408 in the group phase and 478 in the play-offs.
